Dear Webster Families,

The 2009-10 school year is off to a terrific start! Joy and excitement from students and staff filled the first few days of school as we all eagerly looked forward to what this year will bring. It was a pleasure visiting every classroom to review school and district expectations, policies, rules, meet new students and reconnect with returning students. I am thrilled to be a member of a school community where the learner and the learning process are respected and valued!

Webster school hours are from 8:30 to 3:15. Breakfast is served starting at 8:25 and the tardy bell rings at 8:45. All students are expected to be in their classroom and ready for learning at 8:45. It is critical that students arrive on time and stay all day until 3:15. If you need to pick your child up early from school because of an appointment, you must sign your student out in the office. Webster is getting serious about student attendance. Last school year we had 112 students miss 10 or more days of school. Students need to be in school in order for them to learn and develop positive relationships with peers and adults. Thank you in advance for your help and support this year making sure your student is at school on time every day!

Safety of your child continues to be a high priority here at Webster and with the new school year and new families, I thought it would be helpful to share our drop off and pick up process: Any time you drop off or pick up your child please enter the school parking lot off of 7th Avenue and follow the painted arrows around to the front of the school.

Cars are not to enter Webster school off of 6th Street. This is a designated area for Special Education buses and day care buses from 8:20-8:45 and again from 3:10-3:30.

Dismissal at 3:15 - students will be brought out the front doors to parent pick-up. For safety reasons we ask that all parent/guardians wait outside for their student at the end of the day.

This is going to be a fantastic year! Thank you for partnering with us to make the 2009-2010 school year successful for your child.
